Solar lamps transformed nighttime study in Mali. Hermetically sealed crop storage lifted margins in Ghana. Market skills programming supported women entrepreneurs in Burkina Faso.

Policy brief · Risk · Implication · Action

Risk. Risk: currency and logistics volatility compresses margins on imported components.

Implication. Implication: field teams need scenario-based procurement, not single-vendor dependence.

Action. Action: diversify suppliers and pre-fund six months of lamp and sack inventory.
