Executive summary

Governing thought. Climate year investments linked clean energy, reforestation, and coastal waste removal to measurable household savings and student leadership.

Ten thousand seedlings planted, clean cookstoves to three thousand households, and plastic waste cleared from coastal communities with student peer educators leading outreach.

Policy brief · Risk · Implication · Action

Risk. Risk: adoption curves flatten if maintenance and fuel access are not bundled.

Implication. Implication: stove distribution without behaviour support undercounts sustained use.

Action. Action: pair distribution with village maintenance networks and savings groups.
